Inferences from data should be sound -- the author should not reach undue conclusions. entail research methodology, especially those which describe procedures or those which are historical. Is the paccurate? Is it clear that the author knows, or has investigated previous work in the subject of the paper?

Writing Style, References: Please indicate whether there are problems with expression, with grammar, an style. Does the writing need to be tightened; are there many superfluous words; is the paper [unduly] "padde take the time to do copyediting – that will be handled later in the process. However, general comments pointi with style or format are useful.

Highlights and Implications (typically included for full papers only): Do the highlights capture the cri messages of the paper? Highlights should not merely restate the abstract but allow readers to understand the I paper. Implications should address the paper's information practice-related implications.
