Applicant must...

- ... be a member of a minority group, defined as Black or African-American, Hispanic or Latino, Asian, Aboriginal, North American Indian or Alaskan Native, or Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander.
- ... be entering a Masters program at an ALA-accredited graduate library school OR at the time of the granting of the scholarship (February 2018), have completed no more than one-half of the academic requirements of the graduate program.
- ... be a citizen of or have permanent residence in either the United States or Canada.
 - ... not be a past recipient of the MLA Scholarship or the MLA Scholarship for Minority Students
